On Wednesday, the 9/11 Memorial Museum, honoring the nearly 3,000 killed during the 2001 terrorist attacks on the World Trade Center towers in New York City, opened to the public. The 16-acre site features reflecting pools, waterfalls, original towers wreckage... and a gift shop.

Most museums have gift shops, including the United States Holocaust Memorial Museum, but many are taking offense to some of the items for sale at the 9/11 Memorial Museum, including stuffed animals, key chains and cheese plates.

In response to the criticism, museum organizers say the \$65 million needed to run the 9/11 Memorial Museum each year has to come from somewhere. The interior of the museum has a \$24 admission fee, but the outside areas are free to all visitors.

"To provide an opportunity to buy a keepsake and have those proceeds support this open and free memorial is something I would do seven days a week," Joe Daniels, president of the National September 11 Memorial Museum, told CNN.

The museum organizers also told CNN, the museum is in a "respectful place" in the


